JOSEPH Good Option: (Angry) There are still good, honest people here. Struggling to survive in this hellscape that you brought upon us!

JOSEPH (CONT'D) Bad Option: (Sad) If only you saw them, the last remaining scraps of good people that were around. You didn't have to kill them like this. (MORE) JOSEPH (CONT'D) You should be better than those monsters who did this to our home.

Anton moves closer towards Joseph, placing his hand upon Joseph's shoulder.

ANTON

Anton spreads his arms out wide.

ANTON (CONT'D) (Excited) You single handedly fought against armies, monsters our world could not even comprehend. You crawled out of their home like it was nothing!

JOSEPH Good Option: I never did it alone, and I wouldn't have been in their home if you didn't throw me in there!

JOSEPH (CONT'D)

Joseph punches Anton, knocking him to the floor Bad Option: You make it sound easy. Every moment has been hell. (Angry) I have had to claw through it all alone! You left me alone!

> ANTON (RESPONSE:GOOD) All I've ever done is help you. Don't you see that? Ever since we were kids, I have been looking out for you, and you alone.

> > ANTON (RESPONSE: BAD) (CONT'D)

Anton steps back up, his brow furrowed.

ANTON (CONT'D) I know, but it was for your own good. You became so dependent on me, but I knew how strong you could be. You just needed a push. ANTON (CONT'D) This is it. The final moments of this world, isn't that right you fake Goddess?

A flash of bright light, and the Goddess Of Foresight descends, her figure floats above Anton and Joseph

GODDESS This will be the only thing we agree on.

JOSEPH

CUT TO: JOSEPH STANDING OVER GODDESS (BAD ENDING)

GODDESS You could have been so strong, you just needed to believe.

JOSEPH I am strong. I do believe. I just don't believe in you.

GODDESS I know. I am sorry.

JOSEPH For what? Lying to me?

GODDESS For the pain and regret you will have to live with.

JOSEPH I regret nothing.
